- How to better support youth experiencing suicidal ideation.
 - o Funding of youth-specific programming
 - Support for peer-led programming
 - o Improve programming in schools
- How to better support <u>rural Oregonians</u> experiencing suicidal ideation.
 - Funding for rural-specific programming
- How to reduce stigma on suicidal ideation.
 - o Public education campaign
 - Support for health care worker conversations with patients
- Barriers to <u>suicide prevention support</u>.
 - Funding
 - DBT accreditation (Andrew White suggestion)
 - o Interventions by health professionals
- Current <u>community safety protocol</u> across this state, <u>including at hospitals and behavioral health facilities</u>, and recommendations for improvement of the protocol.

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- Locations and events most targeted in community safety threats.
 - o Data collection/dashboard to show hot-spots in real time
- Rates of success for <u>extreme risk protection orders</u> and barriers to implementation and capacity for police stations or other entities to implement voluntary surrender or holding of firearms.
 - o Improved training for law enforcement and DA's
 - Expansion of who can apply for an ERPO
 - o Public education campaign
 - Use of Byrne SCIP grants re ERPO technical assistance, etc. (talk to CJC)
- Barriers to implementing best practices for <u>community safety and suicide</u> <u>prevention</u>.
 - Creation of statewide office of gun violence prevention
 - Continued funding of community violence intervention programs
 - Tax on firearms to help fund this
 - Encouraging safe storage of guns in homes/cars
 - Collaboration with gun dealers to encourage community safety and suicide prevention efforts (messaging, etc.)
 - Safe business practices by gun dealers (including secure inventory storage)

- o Do we need better data?
- How <u>domestic violence</u> is a risk factor for community safety threats and suicide.
