Approval of May meeting minutes

The May minutes were approved without edits.

CJA Report and Application Status and Next Steps

The newest application was submitted and accepted without modifications and is available online. The allocation is slightly lower than last funding cycle which is not uncommon. The funding for CJA comes from the Federal Crime Victim Funds and it is uncertain if there will be a significant impact to future allocations as with VOCA funds.

The vacant Task Force statutorily required member roles were highlighted and recommendations for applicants requested. The group would also like to add a Diversity, Equity and Inclusion professional to the Task Force.

The current Oregon Child Abuse Solutions (OCAS) application, which will end May 2024, will be extended through September 2024 to align with the federal funding schedule and will then transition to the new state-wide funding priorities.



During the recent needs assessment, recommendations for legislative improvements were collected. These are being reviewed for potential actions.

Presentation on Children's Bureau, Child Abuse Prevention and Treatment Act (CAPTA), and Community Based Child Abuse Prevention (CBCAP)

CJA funds must align with the other federal child abuse applications of Children's Bureau, Child Abuse Prevention and Treatment Act (CAPTA), and Community Based Child Abuse Prevention (CBCAP). The group was briefed on each program and funding stream as well as federal reporting for each.

Wrap Up

Regarding upcoming meeting topics, the group requested a presentation on the Family Preservation Act and how it relates to child abuse reporting and supports.

Hotline case assignment has changed and the group suggested an update.
