HB 3265-Sanctuary Violation Reporting

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HB 3265 (ORS 180.805, 180.810, and ORS 181A.820 et seq. ORS 181A.826) states that if a public body receives a communication or request from a federal agency that relates to immigration enforcement, other than a qualifying judicial subpoena, the public body shall decline the request and document the communication or request. The public body shall then report on that request to the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission using this form. CJC will be in contact should further information be needed.

Please note that you must fill out this form in its entirety for it to be accepted.
